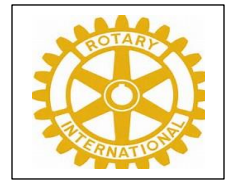

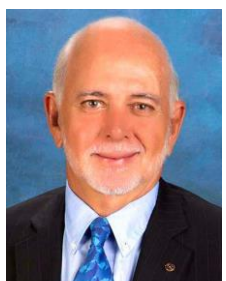

We developed five meals specifically designed for the American palate and added vitamins, minerals and proteins to supplement an unbalanced diet.
