Rotary Trust Fund Giving - Club simple grants are given to local projects and programs, Rotary District Grants consists of District Club Funds and matching designated funds from District for projects and programs, and Global Grants are funded by Rotary International Foundation with matched funds for global projects and programming with clubs around the world supporting large international activities with sustainable high-impact outcomes in one or more of Rotary's six areas of focus with long-term impact. All of our matched fund grant appeals are based on club Rotarians requests and reviewed by Sanibel-Captiva Rotary's giving arm the Rotary Club of Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Trust Foundation club before seeking matching funds from District or RI. Sanibel-Captiva Rotarian TRF Representative, Chet Sadler has been involved in seeking grants from both our Rotary District and Rotary International Grants Funds to established projects/programs the Rotary Club of Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Club Trust Board has researched and reviewed that fits in Rotary's guidelines for funding opportunities.



Recently granted RI Global Grant and District Grants to Sanibel-Captiva Rotary, USA and St. Marc, Haiti Rotary for Villard, Haiti Safe Water Project - Providing equitable community access to safe water, improved sanitation and hygiene; strengthening the ability of communities to develop, fund and maintain sustainable water and sanitation systems; supporting programs that enhance benefit of clean water, sanitation, and hygiene – Total budget of project \$50,020. Total grant funded by Rotary Clubs: Sanibel, Anna Maria Island, Westford FL; West Milford, NJ; Cortland Breakfast Club; NY and St Marc, Haiti. Two of our partnering US Rotary clubs on this Villard Safe Water Projects were home clubs of seasonal Rotarians here on Sanibel...John Fredrick, West Milford, NJ \$1,500 and Lee Schaff, Cortland Breakfast Club, NY \$2,000.



Sanibel Club Pack and Boy Scout Troop 1740 receive Rotary District 6960 matching fund grant for \$5,000 from Sanibel-Captiva Rotary to fund camping and sports equipment that will allow outdoor adventure experiences and the teaching and appreciation of the unique environment surrounding Sanibel and Captiva. Rotarian, Chet Sadler presented the \$5,000 check to Troop Master, Brian Boyd and Assistant Master, Kim Kouril at Sanibel-Captiva Rotary meeting on October 27, 2017.
