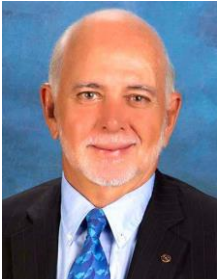

Club Sponsor – John Grey

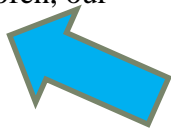
Classification – Marine Biologist

This fascination eventually led him to study zoology at the University of Georgia, earn a master's degree in coral reef biology and sea urchin behavior on Guam, and later complete a Ph.D. in conservation biology at Montana State University. Doc Bruce held academic positions at colleges and field schools, as well as at elementary schools and American Museum of Natural History. His true passion is teaching, and it is his hope that by sharing the wonders of the sea, he will be able to provide his students with a lifetime of discovery and ocean stewardship.

ROTARACT Rotary International 2018/2019 President Barry Rassin said, "Rotaract is Rotary's secret weapon."

ROTARACT is a Rotary sponsored service club for young men and women between the ages of 18 and 30.

Rotary International started the successful Interact clubs, which are younger members, in 1962. It was so successful, many Interactors, reaching the age limit of the program, called themselves Senior Interact Clubs. **Rotary International** then formed the first Rotaract Club in 1965. The name Rotaract was a combination of the words "Rotary" and "Action". The aim of the program was stated to be "to develop leadership and responsible citizenship through service to the community."

Rotaractors are true "partners in service" and key members of the Rotary family, who work hand in hand with Rotarians. They are also a key source for future Rotarians entering a Rotary club. There are now over 10,000 Rotaract clubs in the world. Each sponsored by a Rotary Club.

Our club, along with the other clubs in Area Three, co-sponsors the renewed Rotaract Club at Florida Southwestern. We are represented in that effort by Board of Directors member John Schwandke.
