**SANIBEL-CAPTIVA ROTARY/SANIBEL-CAPTIVA ROTARY TRUST
PLEDGES \$75,000
TO THE SCA SANIBEL COMMUNITY HOUSE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**



The Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Club recognizes the importance of the Sanibel Community House to our Island residents and snowbirds, and their guests. Historically it has been the birthing place of many of our Island's social activities, civic, and non-profit organizations. Currently it is the home of 57 Island organizations. Annual attendance at events held at the SCA Community House or on SCA grounds nears 50,000 attendees.

Rotarians believe the funding of this project aligns itself with the principles of Rotary to sponsor social/business/civic activities, cultural experiences, and educational programming. The SCA Community House offers space for fundraising opportunities for local and global projects serving the needy, environmental, and animal rescue non-profits and offers a variety of education/literacy classes and programming, etc.

The \$75,000 pledge from the Rotary Club of Sanibel-Captiva-\$15,000 a year for five years-has given Rotary the naming rights for the Sanibel Community House stage. It has been agreed upon that upon completion of the restored and renovated Sanibel Community house the auditorium stage will be designated the "Rotary Stage". The Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Club would challenge everyone who has ever stepped inside the Community House in the last 88 years to make a contribution for the restoration and renovation of the Sanibel Community House. Do it now! Don't wait! The Sanibel Community Association/Sanibel Community House needs \$3 million dollars by mid-April 2016 to begin this important construction project. Currently the schedule is to begin construction in April and end by mid-fall. Help the Community House Capital Campaign meet their goal, they are half-way there and need to raise \$1.5 million in the next ten weeks. Big Checks are always welcomed but small ones do add up.
